

## Regarding COVID-19 Virus and the operation of nurseries within Hakusan City

Thank you for your continued understanding and support towards the nursery schools throughout the city. We would also like to show our appreciation for not using the nursery services where possible, and strictly keeping to infection counter measures within your homes.

Due to cases of the virus continuing to be confirmed within the city, we would like to ask you to continue looking after your children at home where possible during the period stated below.

### **1. Period to refrain from (where possible) using nursery services (extension)**

(Previous) 16<sup>th</sup> April (Thu) until 6<sup>th</sup> May (Thu)

(Updated) 16<sup>th</sup> April (Thu) until 31<sup>st</sup> May (Sun)

This is subject to change depending on following developments

### **2. Collection of nursery fees (children under 3 years old)**

For households who have decided to look after their children at home and not use the nursery, during the period stated below, we will calculate a daily rate so you will only have to pay for the days which you used the nursery.

### **3. Fee reduction period**

1<sup>st</sup> April 2020 until 31<sup>st</sup> May 2020

### **4. How to apply**

Once the above fee reduction period has ended, please receive, fill out and hand in the completed form to the nursery facility you are using. Furthermore, The full nursery fee will be collected and then from June onwards, the deductions will be calculated and applied.

### **5. Nursery closure**

If in the future, a child or staff member at the nursery is found to have contracted the virus, then the nursery will be temporarily closed.

### **6. Health management when attending nursery**

- If your child has a fever higher than 37.5 degrees or similar symptoms, then please do not bring your child to nursery and stay at home.
- Even if no such symptoms can be seen, please pay close attention to your child`s health.
